EyeOnWater

The Beverly Hills Mutual Water Company uses remotely readable Badger water meters. These meters read your water consumption every 15 minutes. These reads are stored locally in the meter encoder and read via the cellular network once a day. The software behind the system detects if water is running continuously through your meter. If it sees this condition, the system will report this as a leak and give you the leak rate.

If you have a leak reported, the most likely culprits are a leaky toilet or a hose that you may have left running. In the summer it is not uncommon for sprinkler systems to show a leak when a valve does not completely close after a watering cycle.

A leak of four gallons per hour (gph) can waste 35,040 gallons of water in a year. At our billing rate that comes out to just over \$105 a year that you are throwing down the drain. During the winter months we average 1-3 leaks. During the summer months the active number of leaks increases to 8-12 homes.

To set up your access simply download the EyeOnWater app (or go to EyeOnWater.com) and set up your account:

- 1) Open the EyeOnWater app (or EyeOnWater.com on the web) and click the "Sign Up" button.
- 2) Enter the zip code 80108
- 3) Enter your account number. The EyeOnWater account number is the number printed on your water bill (e.g., 110-001) prefaced with five leading zeroes (00000100-001).
- 4) Once the system recognizes your account number you will be prompted to enter your name, email address and create a password.

Once you have set up your account with the EyeOnWater app, you will also be able to access your account at "EyeOnWater.com" on the web.

Don't forget to set up your leak alert too! Simply log on, click the blue box that says "Set Leak Alert" and follow the prompts. A good default leak rate is 1 gallon per hour.
